

STEPS TO A WELL BERMUDA 2024

SURVEY INTERVIEWERS NEEDED

Join us in taking STEPS to a Well Bermuda by becoming a STEPS interviewer!

Your role will involve conducting face-to-face interviews to collect data on non-communicable disease risk factors (STEP 1), taking physical measurements, including height and weight (STEP 2) and arranging appointments for biochemical measurements (STEP 3). This information is important in assessing the health of Bermuda's residents and guiding health initiatives.

The STEPS to a Well Bermuda survey will start in June 2024 and run for at least 12 weeks. Interviewers will be assigned a list of households to visit throughout this period, requiring approximately 10-12 hours of evening and weekend work per week. Personal transportation is required. Payment is \$40 per completed household interview, provided the data is suitable for analysis.

A minimum Bermuda Secondary School Certificate (BSSC) or equivalent is required. While no prior experience is necessary, preference may be given to candidates with previous survey or interviewing experience and/or a background or interest in health-related fields. Short-listed applicants must undergo interviewer training and assessment, which is mandatory for securing the position.
