Services/Works

DESCRIPTION OF WORK

- 1.1. The work included in this contract is for the labour plant, materials and supervision of power washing/sanitizing of the existing bus shelters located in the Eastern, Central & Western Parishes separately. Each separate contract will contain 3 parishes relevant to the area specified. **One contractor will only be awarded a maximum of one contract.**
- 1.2. The Contractor shall:
 - Carry out only those works instructed by the Ministry Representative(s).
 - Provide all labour, plant, materials, and supervision.
 - Execute the works in accordance with this specification.
- 1.3. The Contractor shall be engaged to carry out power washing/ sanitizing services only at locations instructed by the Ministry Representative(s). The Power washing/sanitizing services shall be confined to bus shelters only and shall not extend beyond the instructed limits unless directed by the Ministry Representative(s). The extent of each power washing/ sanitizing service shall be defined by the Ministry Representative(s), and no additional work shall be carried out without instruction.
- 1.4. Ministry of Public Works will provide a list of acceptable detergents to be used on site. The contractor will need to submit detergent type for approval BEFORE use on site.
- 1.5. Each power washing/sanitizing shall include:
 - Clearing of the area of any loose debris by sweeping the area with a broom or leaf blower to prevent dragging large rocks or dirt across the surface
 - Application of appropriate sanitizing/cleaning detergent to all exposed surfaces within the area. Allow for the necessary time for product to activate.
 - Power washing of all exposed surfaces within the bus shelter area.
 - Once power washing is completed rinse away all remaining debris and residue from cleaning products
 - Finishing the cleaning/sanitizing by removing all machinery, tools, cleaning products and leave the bus shelter in an organized manner. Move benches and bins into position if moved
 - Allow adequate time for drying before reopening to the public
