Child Day Care Allowance *Increase*

More monthly support for families with more than one child under age 4. New amendments raise the allowance for each additional eligible child.

What this means for families

- ✓ Families with **more than one child under 4** can receive higher monthly day care allowances.
- ✓ The allowance grows for your **second child** — and keeps increasing for **each additional eligible child**.
- ✓ Awards are still based on your **gross annual household income** (Categories 1–3).
