EXPANSION OF SERVICES

Retail stores

Retail stores to open for in-store customers and the standard is a maximum of 20% of the store's occupancy capacity as calculated in accordance with guidance.

Schools

- Public and private schools and Bermuda College are open.
- Licensed/registered Day Care Centre and Home Providers are open.

Weddings, Funerals and Religious Services

Indoor services: number of persons cannot exceed 20% of seating capacity up to a maximum of 25 persons. Masks must be worn.

Outdoor services: maximum of 25 persons.

Working from home

No longer mandatory but strongly encouraged.

Restaurants and bars

- Restaurants open for outdoor dining and **NOT** dining indoors.
- Table service only, maximum six persons per table, tables spaced 6ft apart. Patrons must wear masks when not seated.

Gyms

Open with equipment to be spaced 6ft apart. All persons must wear masks indoors and maintain 6ft physical distance. No high intensity, aerobic, or any other activity that requires a mask to be removed are allowed indoors. Masks not required for outdoor classes with 6ft physical distance between persons.

Event Facilities

Movie theatres, libraries, galleries, etc. number of persons cannot exceed 20% capacity up to a maximum of 25 persons. Masks must be worn.

Boating

- Recreational boating is allowed until 8pm with no more than ten persons using the boat (including crew).
- Commercial boats are allowed the capacity set through Marine & Ports licensing and cannot be on the water after curfew.

Recreation

- Playgrounds and outdoor gym equipment are open.

Personal services

Barber shops, beauty salons, spas, massage therapists are prohibited from providing services which require face masks to be removed.

Gathering and Mixing

Limited numbers for gatherings (no more than ten people with physical distancing in place).

The mixing of households is not prohibited but is strongly discouraged.

THE BERMUDA POLICE SERVICE AND ROYAL BERMUDA REGIMENT WILL BE MONITORING PHYSICAL DISTANCING AND PUBLIC HEALTH STANDARD COMPLIANCE.

CURFEW IN PLACE FROM 10PM – 5AM
