RE: Heritage Wharf Cathodic Protection

The Government of Bermuda, Ministry of Public Works has received the following questions from interested bidders and offers the following answers that will form Addendum 3.

The following addendum supersedes information contained in drawings and specifications issued for this project to the extent referenced. This addendum forms part of the Tender Documents and is subject to all of the conditions set out in the contract conditions.

- 1. Do you have the location of rectifier room designed or that will be determines later and do we have to allow for the design and build in our price?
 - Response: The design, build and proposed location is to form part of your proposal.
- 2. For clarification purposes, are we doing all of the piles or just certain selected ones, if so can you confirm there are only 61 piles we are providing coverage for.
 - Response: Per Part 1.2 of Annex A Scope of Work, we are seeking coverage for 289 piles, in addition to the rebar within the deck, bridge and dolphins (item 1.1.1.1)
- 3. Drawing S-5 does not list the dimensions for the sheet. However, S-22 indicates there are 88 sheet piles present on the dock and no indication these are receiving cathodic protection. Please confirm these are beyond the scope of this bid. If they are within the scope, please provide the sheet pile depths and any other dimensional details.
 - These sheet piles do not form part of this RFP
- Please confirm that a NACE Cathodic Protection Specialist CP4 with extensive experience
 offshore would be an acceptable equivalent to a Level 3 Marine Sector specialist in accordance
 with BS EN 15257.
 - An experienced offshore NACE Cathodic Protection Specialist CP4 would be accepted as equivalent to a Level 3 Marine Sector specialist in accordance with BS EN 15257.
- 5. Please confirm that topside welding is allowed to the pile during the anode replacement phase after 10 years.
 - Topside welding may be allowed to the pile during 10th year anode replacement but we require to see the method documented including specification of post weld remediation / corrosion protection.
