The following addendum supersedes information contained in the solicitation document issued for this procurement to the extent referenced. This Addendum forms part of the solicitation documents and will be subject to all of the conditions set out in the contract conditions. Questions and Reponses to Questions

Question 1:	Is this in fact the second allotment / stimulus round of LED lights and the first round was completed and distributed or is this the second attempt at rolling out the first allotment?
Answer 1:	As noted in Section 1.1, this is the second allotment of the initiative.

Question 2:	Are these items duty exempt into Bermuda?
Answer 2:	No. The duty is payable as per the Bermuda Customs Tariff 2023.

Question 3:	What is the time period in which these bulbs are expected to be distributed/given to consumers, will they need to be procured all at once, or can they be procured, stored and distributed in a staggered approach and timeframe?
Answer 3:	The distribution is anticipated to take place in a staggered approach throughout the fiscal year (April 2023 through March 2024.

Question 4:	Where and to how many locations across the island will these bulbs be delivered/distributed?
Answer 4:	The precise locations are to be determined, but will likely be three main locations: one East, one West, and one Central.

Question 5:	Will they be delivered to consumers' residential homes or to centralized locations across the island for consumers to go and pick up?
Answer 5:	See response to Question 4 above; the LED bulbs will not be delivered to customers' homes.
