

   Ensure the smooth running of an office by taking responsibility for administrative, financial, or managerial tasks.

# • Telecommunications Officer:

Monitor and enforce telecommunication licenses and provide technical facilities management and advice on telecommunication matters.

# Social Media Officer:

Oversee digital strategies for Government Departments and update the Government portal, intranet, social media, and partner websites to elevate the public service's visibility and effectiveness.

# Public Media Relations Officer:

Create strategic communication plans to promote Public Service initiatives and manage the Department's reputation.

# Photographer:

Produce professional images for creative, technical and documentary usages (i.e., Government portal, social media or historical record).

# Graphic Designer:

Design, produce and install high-quality interpretive materials both online and in print for the education and enjoyment of viewers.

- Strong interpersonal, verbal, and written communication skills
- Able to meet deadlines, multitask and work well under pressure
- Work with minimal supervision

Jobs at the forefront of upholding standards and maintaining public safety and security by ensuring adherence to laws and regulations.




# **TYPES OF JOBS:**

- Maritime Enforcement Officer:

  Oversee the fisheries enforcement programme,
  manage case preparations for prosecution, and lead
  community outreach and education initiatives.
- Investigative Officer:

  Conduct investigations into complaints, offer conciliatory services, and carry out research; draft reports of formal complaints for review
- Compliance Officer
   Oversee monitoring and compliance enforcement through inspections and technical evaluations.
   Conduct inquiries to recommend actions for delinquency.

# **TYPES OF JOBS:**

• Intelligence Evaluator:

Responsible for evaluating, updating, collating, and guarding intelligence reports, events, crimes, incidents and records.

**EDUCATION** 

High school diploma plus a diploma in computer network administration or related qualification

• Data Processor:

Responsible for processing, managing, organising and ensuring the accuracy of collected data to be transformed into meaningful and actionable insights.

**EDUCATION** 

High school diploma

• Librarian:

Responsible for overseeing and managing Government libraries, including database maintenance and library collection management.

**EDUCATION** 

ALA (American Library Association) Accredited Graduate degree or equivalent

Archivist:

Responsible for the preservation, management, restoration of and access to the archives

**EDUCATION** 

Graduate degree in Archival Science (MAS) or an ALA Graduate degree with a concentration in archives and records management

Undergraduate degree or Higher National Diploma (HND) in engineering, with a concentration in a relevant field (Mechanical, Electrical, Marine, etc.). Upon graduation, must obtain a professional certification (e.g. P.Eng, C.Eng) for the area of concentration



# **TYPES OF JOBS:**

# • Veterinary Officer:

Oversee animal husbandry and welfare, disease control, and the protection of endangered species while managing veterinary services.

**EDUCATION** 

Professional Veterinary Medical Degree, i.e. DVM, VMD, BVetMed or equivalent.

# Aquarist & Zookeeper:

Provide appropriate care, maintenance and improvement of all zoo exhibits at the Bermuda Aquarium, Museum and Zoo. Perform administrative duties associated with providing zookeeping services and undertake outreach and liaison-related duties.

**EDUCATION** 

Associate degree in Aquarium science, Environmental science, Marine biology, Zoology or related discipline.

# Hydrogeologist:

Oversee groundwater management and pollution control, coordinate research on environmental impacts, and enforce regulatory compliance.

**EDUCATION** 

Graduate degree in Geology or a related discipline.

# Environmental Officer:

Enforces air and water protection laws by conducting environmental assessments, preparing reports, offering expert advice on pollution and waste management, and collaborating with environmental NGOs.

**EDUCATION** 

Undergraduate degree in Environment Management or a related science.





• Marine Conservation Officer:

Conduct research and laboratory work focused on data collection and analysis for the population assessment and conservation of threatened species. Maintain protected dive site moorings and manage the operation and upkeep of section vessels.

**EDUCATION** 

Undergraduate in Marine Ecology, Marine Biology, Biological Sciences, Fisheries, Marine Resources Management, Marine Conservation or related discipline. Certification in Rescue SCUBA Diver, CPR, Oxygen Provider, First Aid, and Bermuda "C" Class Pilot's Licence.

Jobs dedicated to fostering a supportive workplace, enhancing employee engagement and driving organisational growth through strategic resource management.



# **TYPES OF JOBS:**

# • Compensation Officer:

Oversees compensation compliance and payroll administration, ensuring adherence to financial guidelines and managing employee enrolment in health and dental insurance programmes

**EDUCATION** 

Associate degree in Accounting, Business Administration, Business Management, Finance or related discipline

# • Talent Partner:

Provides talent management services to champion the Government of Bermuda's efforts to attract, train and retain its talent to achieve organizational goals and objectives.

**EDUCATION** 

Undergraduate degree in Business Administration, Human Resource Management, or related discipline

## Recruiter:

Performs duties related to the full life cycle of recruitment and selection.

**EDUCATION** 

Undergraduate degree in Human Resource Management, Business Administration or related discipline

Delivers HR technical support across departments, offering advice, coordinating HR projects and solutions and aiding in the implementation of initiatives to promote a healthy work environment

Provide support pertaining to the administration of the Legal Aid Scheme, review laws and maintain records.

**EDUCATION** 

Qualified Barrister and/or Attorney of a Commonwealth jurisdiction

• Forensic Accountant:

Conduct analysis for the determination of levels of financial crime and money laundering, determination of financial sanctions and the preparation of financial data regarding criminal activity.

**EDUCATION** 

Undergraduate degree in Business, Science; Qualified accountant with a professional designation (i.e. CA, CPA, SMA) and forensic designation such as CFE or CA-FA.

• Investigations Officer (Human Rights):
Undertake investigations, handle complaints, facilitate settlements and provide advice to educate the public to ensure compliance with the Human Rights Acts 1981.

Legislative Editor:

Responsible for ensuring the accuracy and quality of bills, regulations and other statutory instruments.



# PARKS AND RECREATION

Professionals play a crucial role in managing and enhancing the beauty and sustainability of Bermuda's parks and nature reserves, focusing on the supervision of public use, the development and implementation of enjoyment programmes, and the protection of natural and cultural resources.



# **TYPES OF JOBS:**

# • Park Ranger:

Supervise public usage of parks and nature reserves, operate programmes for the public enjoyment of these areas and conduct schemes to protect the natural and cultural resources and park users.

# **EDUCATION**

Undergraduate degree in Social Science or Environmental Management plus law enforcement certification.

# Park Planner:

Design landscapes, oversee capital projects, renovate historical sites, maintain and improve the Railway Trail and conduct research on the environmental and historical aspects of the park system.

# **EDUCATION**


Graduate degree in Planning, Landscape Architecture, Architecture or relevant field of study.

# • Curator (Botanical Gardens):

Manage Bermuda Botanical Gardens and the Arboretum, its plant collection and facilities. Develop and formulate a management plan and policies for the Bermuda Botanical Gardens and the Arboretum and other areas.

**EDUCATION** 

Undergraduate degree in Ornamental Horticulture or equivalent.





Superintendent of Horticulture:
Ensure the production of high-quality plant materials for public spaces and maintain nursery facilities for optimal propagation and cultivation, aimed to enrich the community's connection to natural and historical treasures.

**EDUCATION** 

Higher National Diploma or equivalent in Plant Nursery Management, Horticulture or relevant field of study.

- Computer literate (e.g., Microsoft Suite)
- Able to handle confidential information
- Organisational skills and ability to meet deadlines

Jobs that provide support for building committees, manage the building of new structures and the repair of preexisting structures. Prepare reports pertaining to the suitability and sustainability of building projects, ensuring enforcement of building control legislation to ensure compliance and, collaborate with suppliers to maintain LT Registry Index Mapping and GEO Info Systems.

   Support the Department of Employee and Organisational Development to ensure consistent interpretation and application of policy, provide policy advice and develop, review and communicate policies and strategies that support an effective HR service for the Public Service.

Responsible for analysing controlled substances and biological specimens, performing other associated laboratory duties, and conducting research to stay current with advancements in laboratory technology.

- Analyse controlled substances and biological specimens
- Exhibit attention to detail and high accuracy
- Mathematical and statistical skills
- Able to work under pressure and meet deadlines
- Work independently and with minimal supervision
- Execute laboratory tests and procedures.
- Knowledgeable in the foundational principles, theories, and practices of clinical laboratory sciences.

**EDUCATION** 

Undergraduate degree of science or equivalent in forensic science, biochemistry, chemistry or related field of discipline.



Professionals dedicated to helping individuals, families, and communities improve their quality of life through counselling, advocacy, and reporting.

• Clinical/Forensic Psychologist:

Mitigate risks to the community by those who commit offences and provide support for clients and their families.

Perform investigations, assess clients, develop treatment plans, and evaluate progress.

Manage a caseload of substance-dependent clients and provide substance abuse treatment

# 5.1 PUBLIC SERVICE BURSARY AWARDS SCHEME

Our Public Service Bursary Awards Scheme provides up to \$20,000 in annual funding to Bermudians pursuing post-secondary academic qualifications in a discipline identified to meet future needs of Government Departments.

# Eligible candidates must:

- Be Bermudian:
- Have completed no less than 5 years of schooling in Bermuda:
- Be 40 years of age or under at the date of application;
- Have been accepted into an institution of higher learning or currently undertaking courses leading to a professional, specialist or technical qualification required within the Public Service:
- Be in a specifically accredited Undergraduate or Graduate degree programme; and;
- Be planning a career in the Public Service upon completion of their education.
