Part 1 Invitation and Submission Instructions

Bidder's Questions (Q) and Governments Responses (R)

- Q1 Could you please extend the submission date to accommodate for the amendments in the RFP?
- R1 The Government has considered this request and the new deadline is January 31st 2020 at 3:00 p.m.
- Q2 Can the Government clarify and give further details on their requirements for the completion of the Project and Personnel form (Annex D)?
- Please be advised the Government has decided to withdraw the use of the original "Project Personnel Qualifications and Reference form" (Annex D). In its place, the Proposal shall clearly identify the names of all personnel of the proposed team (and sub-contractors) that are to be assigned to the response for proposal (RFP).
- Q3 It is stated that the proposal must be submitted by mail to the address given on page 5 of the RFP. Can this be changed to be submitted by email to ensure that the documents will arrive on time?
- Please be advised that submissions may be sent via email to dblovell@gov.bm In addition
 Proponents may submit at minimum 3 original signed hard copies of their proposal or one
 (1) electronic copy (e-copy) in Microsoft Word or Adobe PDF format. If both a hard copy and e-copy of the proposal are submitted and there is a conflict or inconsistency between the hard copy and the e-copy of the proposal, the hard copy of the proposal will prevail.

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- Q4 The date for submission is set to Friday January 10, but in paragraph 1.5.3 it is stated that the bids will open on Friday January 03. Is this is an error?
- **R4** The Government confirms this was an editing error
- Q5 On the Proponent Information page you ask for Social Insurance Number and Payroll Tax Number issued by the Government of Bermuda Does this apply to overseas proponents?
- **R5** The Government confirms this does not apply to overseas proponents
- Q6 What radio brand and model is in use by the Bermuda Fire and Rescue Service? Does the radio have Bluetooth capabilities?
- R6 The Bermuda Fire & Rescue Service will be migrating to a new radio system on the "Tetra" platform. The system was manufactured by Sepura and it is the SC20 model with Bluetooth capabilities.
- Q7 Can the Government clarify its pricing sheet structure to denote the separation of the costs of optional items versus mandatory items?
- **R7** With regards to the existing pricing sheet, proponents should be aware that pricing information may be presented in any format provided that it denotes our required items versus our optional.
