#### Part 2 Questions (Q) and Government's Responses (R). -

1. (Q) Can the Quarry be used as Lay Down area to do the work required on the floating dock units?

(R) Yes. Blasting, painting and other works will be permitted at Quarry. The contractor will need to give notice to the depot foreman, ensure works don't interfere with normal operations at quarry and keep the work area tidy.

- 2. (Q) Can mobilization and demobilisation charges be split to reflect the fact that project will be done over 4 budget years?
  - (R) Yes. Pricing form has been updated accordingly (attached).
- 3. (Q) Who confirms extent of damage of the dock pieces that need to be repaired?

(R) <u>Damage in coating</u>: The project requires that the contractor brings an independent qualified inspector from overseas to verify that surface preparation and coating procedures satisfy the project specifications. Inspector's reports and recommendations will need to be provided to government.

<u>Damage beyond the coating:</u> After initial cleaning, and before final surface preparation, a representative of MPW will attend a walk-through with the contractor to identify and measure any areas that need repairs. The contractor should also bring to the representative's attention any areas that they find concerning. The structural repairs required (plates, welds, etc) and corresponding costs will need to be agreed upon by MPW before commencing of any repair works.
