


COVID-19TravellerQuarantine Instructions

Welcome to Bermuda! Please review the following information to support your on island experience. Before your arrival, you should have applied for a Travel Authorisation. If you have not completed this, please visit: www.gov.bm/coronavirus-travellers

Upon arrival in Bermuda, you will be seen by a health officer who will:

- Take your temperature
- Ask for a copy of your pre-departure PCR COVID-19 test result, if you took one
- Ask for a copy of your Travel Authorisation
- Identify the guarantine instructions (below) you must follow while you are in Bermuda as per the Quarantine Act 2017 Per the Quarantine Act 2017 s.11 and the Quarantine (COVID-19)(No.3) Order 2020, failure to comply may result in a fine of \$25,000 and/or imprisonment for up to 6 months



Pre-departure COVID-19 Test

You will test on arrival

You will quarantine until you get a negative result on day 3

REFUSAL of COVID-19 Test on arrival (Adults and children 10 and older)

You must quarantine for 14 days

- Must quarantine at your accommodation until a negative test result is received (approx. 6-8 hours, though it can take longer at times). Children 0-9 quarantine with parent or guardian until the parent or guardian receive their negative result.
- Negative test result received, feel free to enjoy Bermuda.
- Wear a mask, wash your hands, and maintain physical distance.
- Test on day 4, 8 and 14.
- The date, times and locations are available here: www.gov.bm/coronavirus-gettested. A reminder email will be sent 24 hours before your test.
- Please monitor your health daily and take your temperature twice daily for 14 days. Record any symptoms and your temperature on the Symptom and Temperature Log (see back).
- If you temperature is over 100.4F or 38C please email: covid19surv@gov.bm.
- Must quarantine in your room at your accommodation until a negative test result is received from your day 3 test. You may have to wear a quarantine bracelet.
- Children 0-9 quarantine with parent or guardian until the parent or guardian receive their negative result from the day 3 test.
- Receive a negative PCR COVID-19 test from day 3, feel free to enjoy Bermuda.
- Wear a mask, wash your hands, and maintain physical distance.
- Test on days 8 and 14. The dates, times and location are available here: www.gov.bm/coronavirus-get-tested
- A reminder email will be sent 24 hours before your test.
- Please monitor your health daily and take your temperature twice daily for 14 days. Record any symptoms and your temperature on the Symptom and Temperature Log (see back)
- If you temperature is over 100.4F or 38C please email: covid19surv@gov.bm
- Must quarantine in your room at your accommodation. You may have to wear a quarantine bracelet. Children aged 0-9 must quarantine with parent or guardian.
- Please monitor your health daily and take your temperature twice daily. Record your symptoms and temperature on the Symptom and Temperature Log (see back)
- Ifyourtemperature is over 100.4For 38C please email: covid19surv@gov.bm.
- Children aged 10-17, whose parents or guardians refuse to have them tested on arrival must quarantine for 14 days with adult supervision.
- You may test on day 14. A reminder email will be sent 24 hours before your test. The date, times and locations are available here: www.gov.bm/coronavirus-get-tested
- If you refuse a test again on day 14, you must quarantine an additional 14 days.

Positive COVID-19 Result

If a traveller becomes COVID-19 positive, is a close contact of a positive person, is symptomatic, or if a traveller is clinically diagnosed at any point, they will be isolated at their accommodation for up to 14 days. Anyone who becomes COVID-19 positive, or whom health authorities believe could be positive, will be fitted with an electronic bracelet to assist with isolation/quarantine.
