Part 1 GENERAL

1.1 Scope of Work

- .1 The Landing Stage at Clearance Cove requires repairs to provide a safe area for swimming and boating and to extend its useful life.
- .2 The area is a popular swimming, diving and boating facility.
- .3 It is not expected that the entire Landing Stage will not be repaired with this budget so the priority will be working from the eastern end of the Landing towards the western end.
- .4 The Contractor shall submit method statements with the Tender to demonstrate how they intend to undertake the works and shall provide details showing the work to be completed within the Project Budget as stated in Sub-Clause 1.2 Project Budget.
- .5 The Work shall include;
 - .1 Designing and making repairs to the existing concrete structure, both above and below the waterline
 - .2 The removal of numerous pieces of rock and concrete that have fallen into the water to ensure that no hazards remain for boating and swimming
 - .3 The addition of bollards to secure small boats for short term berthing
 - .4 Areas to be repaired include the top, sides and end of the Landing
 - .5 Provide detailed repair methods that clearly show the proposed manner that concrete repairs will be secured to the existing works, both for small levelling patches and large infill sections
 - .6 Provide sketches of the areas proposed to be repaired
- .6 The Contractor shall phase their works to minimize disruption to the Public using a safe construction management methodology.

1.2 Project Budget

- .1 The project budget is \$50,000.00.
- .2 This budget must cover the cost of the design and construction of the proposed repairs.
- .3 There is no allowance for work outside this budget value.
