An import permit issued by the Department of Environmental Protection and an invoice from the exporting country, must accompany all shipments of beneficial insects/nematodes arriving in Bermuda. Imports arriving without this documentation will be confiscated and destroyed.

All insect/nematode shipments must be delivered **directly** to the Department of Environmental Protection for inspection. Consignee must be the Department of Environmental Protection.
