TO ALL ATTORNEYS AND LITIGANTS IN PERSON

DISTRIBUTION OF ELECTRONIC SUPREME COURT CAUSE BOOK

This Practice Direction is issued further to Circular 13 of 2022.

WITH IMMEDIATE EFFECT:

- (1) Searches of the Supreme Court Cause Books may be carried out during the usual Registry opening hours. Appointments are not required.
- (2) As you will all be aware, the commencement of issuing the Supreme Court Cause Book in an electronic format was implemented solely as a matter of convenience for those wishing to carry out searches due to health and safety concerns which arose due to the Covid-19 Pandemic.
- (3) Given the Supreme Court's current limited resources, the Court is suspending the distribution of the electronic copy of the Supreme Court Cause Book until <u>24 February 2023</u>.
- (4) Those firms and members of the public who have submitted requests to-date will receive the electronic version of the Supreme Court Cause Book which will be up-to-date as of 29 November 2022.
