

Midwives

The Bermuda Nursing and Midwifery Council establishes and maintains a register of nurses, midwives and nursing associates. A nurse, a midwife and a nursing associate must make an Application for Retention to the Council every two (2) years, having been engaged in the practice of nursing, and or midwifery as the case may be, for the prescribed number of hours per year in the two year period immediately prior to the date of application.

Every nurse, midwife and nursing associate shall complete a prescribed number of hours of continuing professional education that the Council may approve of for nurses, midwives or nursing associates. Registration and proof of registration must be displayed or made available on request. Practitioners currently registered are listed below. Nurses, Midwives and Nursing Associates are reminded that it is an offense against, The Nursing and Midwifery Act 1997, Nursing and Midwifery Rules 2010, to practice nursing and or midwifery in Bermuda if their registration is not current.
