TO ALL ATTORNEYS and Judicial Department

Please be advised that effective **5th October 2015**, the Supreme Court Divorce and Matrimonial Proceedings section will move to the 3rd Floor of the Dame Lois Browne-Evans Building (DLBE) located at 58 Court Street, Hamilton HM 12. This effectively will be the start of the Integrated Family Court which will be overseen by The Hon. Justice Norma Wade-Miller working in conjunction with the Family Court Magistrates. Please note that Justice Wade-Miller has new Administrative Assistant, Mrs. Tanya Perott-Loder. For now and until we can do it differently, contacting them will be through the Supreme Court Registry switchboard - **292-1350**.

As best as can be organized, most of the matrimonial proceedings will take place over in the DLBE. Depending on the availability of the judge, there will be times where such matters have to be moved back to Supreme Court Chambers.

What used to be Thursday Chambers for family matters (ancillary relief, care, custody, control issues, etc.) will now be heard in the DLBE on **Fridays**. Adjust your calendars accordingly. Divorces will now be heard in the DLBE on the last Friday in the month. You will be directed to the appropriate Courtroom.

Any and all Supreme Court documents, summonses etc. relating to divorces/family matters should continue to be filed at the Supreme Court Registry on Front Street in the usual manner.
