The Government of Bermuda would like enter into an agreement with suitably qualified Bulk Fuel Suppliers to provide diesel and gasoline for its fleet of vehicles. The agreement will extend over the next 10 or 15 years, depending on the agreed term of the contract, and it will include improvements to the Government's fuel storage and dispensing facilities located around the Island.
