EXPANSION OF SERVICES

Version 1 Updated 1 June 2021

Retail and Grocery Stores

Open for in-store customers. No restrictions on capacity.

Schools

- Public and private schools and Bermuda College are open.
- Licensed/registered Children's Day Care Centre and Home Providers are open.

Religious Services

Indoor and outdoor services allowed. Maximum gathering size does not apply provided Public Health measures are applied. Congregations to wear masks; officiants/choirs to wear masks if unable to maintain 6ft distance.

Working from home

No longer required. Offices are open. Public Health and social measures continue to apply.

Restaurants, Bars, Nightclubs,

Sports/Members Clubs

- Open for indoor dining and seated bar service.
- Maximum ten persons per table, tables spaced 6ft apart. Patrons must wear masks when not seated.

Gyms

Equipment spaced 6ft. Staff, personal trainers and patrons must wear a mask when not working out, and maintain 6ft physical distance. Outdoor classes to maintain 6ft physical distance and masks not required.

Event Facilities

Movie theatres, libraries, galleries, etc. up to a maximum of 50 persons. Masks must be worn.

Weddings, Funerals and Domestic Partnerships

Indoor and outdoor ceremonies allowed up to maximum of 50 people. Wakes and receptions allowed up to maximum 50 people. Masks must be worn. Public Health and social measures continue to apply.

Boating

- Allowed between 5am and 11pm. Persons can remain on boat, moored, berthed or anchored overnight from 11pm to 5am. If staying overnight, must remain on boat through night-time curfew.
- Commercial boats are allowed and not limited by group size restrictions. Limited capacity per Marine & Ports licensing for island boats.

Recreation

 Playgrounds and outdoor gym equipment are open.

Personal services

May provide services which require face masks to be removed. Staff must wear masks at all times.

Gathering and Mixing

Maximum of 50 people. Minister of National Security will have ability to issue exemptions to gathering size maximum.

THE BERMUDA POLICE SERVICE AND ROYAL BERMUDA REGIMENT WILL BE MONITORING PHYSICAL DISTANCING AND PUBLIC HEALTH STANDARD COMPLIANCE.

CURFEW IN PLACE FROM 12AM - 5AM
