Personal Services

Permitting full personal services, subject to public health guidelines, to include facial grooming and personal waxing, spas, tattooing, massage.



Grocery Shopping

Same rules for alphabet grocery shopping.

Monday and Thursday: **A-F** Tuesday and Friday: **G-Q** Wednesday and Saturday: **R-Z** Sunday: **Seniors**



Community and Members' Clubs

Can operate on the same basis as bars, providing outdoor service if they hold a liquor license.

Bars and Nightclubs

Bars (indoor) and night-clubs remain closed.



Commercial Vessels

Permitting commercially licensed vessels to operate in accordance with their licensed capacity, subject to appropriate physical distancing;

Gatherings

Limited numbers for gatherings no more than 20 people with physical distancing in place.

*MASKS MUST BE WORN IN ALL PUBLIC PLACES.

THE BERMUDA POLICE SERVICE AND ROYAL BERMUDA REGIMENT WILL BE MONITORING PHYSICAL DISTANCING AND PUBLIC HEALTH STANDARD COMPLIANCE.
