PUBLIC HEALTH (COVID-19 EMERGENCY POWERS) (PHASED RE-OPENING)  
AMENDMENT (NO. 9) REGULATIONS 2021

Her Excellency the Governor, on the advice of the Minister responsible for health, and in exercise of the power conferred by section 107B of the Public Health Act 1949, makes the following Regulations:

Citation

1 These Regulations, which amend the Public Health (COVID-19 Emergency Powers) (Phased Re-opening) Regulations 2021 (“the principal Regulations”), may be cited as the Public Health (COVID-19 Emergency Powers) (Phased Re-opening) Amendment (No. 9) Regulations 2021.

Amends regulation 2

2 After the definition of “commencement” in regulation 2, insert—

“COVID-19 vaccination certificate” means a vaccination certificate issued in Bermuda by the Ministry of Health and signed by the Chief Medical Officer which confirms that a person has had a full course of vaccination against the SARS - COV2 virus;”.

Amends regulation 5

3 In regulation 5 of the principal Regulations, paragraph (5A) is revoked.

Amends regulation 8A

4 In regulation 8A of the principal Regulations, in subparagraph (a), after “SafeKey” insert “or a valid COVID-19 vaccination certificate”.
