






How to Quarantine one child in a multi-sibling household

You and your spouse are parents to two children. One child attends the same school as a close contact of a positive COVID-19 case and has been told to quarantine.

The other child goes to a different school.





If you are able to quarantine the affected sibling away from other sibling and parent, then the non affected sibling may still attend school and the other parent can go to work.

If you are not able to keep the household members apart, then both siblings should quarantine and the parents should not attend work.
