**PROCLAMATION**


By His Excellency Mr John Rankin CMG, Governor and  
Commander-in-Chief in and over Bermuda.

WHEREAS it is provided by section 49(1) of the  
Constitution that the Governor, acting in accordance  
with the advice of the Premier, may at any time, by  
proclamation published in the Gazette, dissolve the  
Legislature:

NOW THEREFORE I, the Governor, acting in  
accordance with the advice which I have received from  
the Premier, do hereby dissolve the Legislature with  
effect from 5:00 p.m. on Friday the 21st day of August,  
two thousand and twenty.

this 21st day of August two thousand and twenty, in the

**PROCLAMATION**

WHEREAS section 51(1) of the Constitution provides that a  
general election of Members of the House of Assembly shall  
be held at such time within three months after every  
dissolution of the Legislature as the Governor shall appoint by  
proclamation published in the Gazette;

AND WHEREAS under and in accordance with the  
provisions of section 49(1) of the Constitution the Legislature  
is dissolved with effect from 5:00 p.m. on Friday the 21st day  
of August, two thousand and twenty:

NOW THEREFORE I, the Governor, acting in  
accordance with the advice which I have received from  
the Premier, do hereby appoint the 1st day of October, two  
thousand and twenty, as the day on which a general election
