<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Negative PCR COVID-19 test result taken within 7 days of departure 2. Must be performed by an accredited laboratory. 3. Test result must show your name, your date of birth, your address, name/address/telephone number and email address of the laboratory, date of the test and result. 4. The test result must be uploaded to the Travel Authorisation. 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Complete the TA application within 48 hours of departure. One for each person travelling. 2. Upload a negative PCR COVID-19 test result taken no more than 7 days before departure.** 3. Complete personal and health information. 4. Pay \$75 for 10-year-olds and up, \$30 for 9-years-old and younger. Only Visa and Mastercard are accepted. 5. Sign the TA agreeing to comply with all quarantine and testing requirements. Parents must consent for testing for children 10 to 17-years-old. Without consent, the children must quarantine for 14-days. 6. Keep an electronic or hard copy of the TA to show the airline to be able to board. 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Show the airlines a copy of your TA 2. Wear a mask in all public places. Children under the age of 2 must NOT wear a mask. 3. Bring a thermometer. 4. Keep physical distance at all times. 5. Have Health Insurance to cover illness outside of your jurisdiction including COVID-19 related illness. 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Show an electronic or hard copy of your TA to the Health Officer. 2. Show an electronic or hard copy of your negative PCR COVID-19 test results to the Health Officer. 3. Undergo PCR COVID-19 testing at the airport. You must immediately quarantine until you receive a negative test result (12 to 24 hours turnaround time). 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Take a taxi or private resident travel to your accommodation – NOT public transport. 2. Quarantine in your room at your accommodation until arrival test results received. Residents without a pre-departure test MUST quarantine until negative test results from the day 4 test. 3. Test on day 4, 8 and 14. You will be booked into your days and times. These will be emailed to you 24 hours before. 4. Monitor your health and record your temperature twice daily and any symptoms.

*Required for visiting adults and children age 10 to 17 –years-old. Residents are strongly encouraged to get a negative PCR COVID-19 Test results before returning to Bermuda.

**As of 19th August 2020, must upload the following to obtain a Travel Authorisation. Children 9-years-old or younger must upload a government issued photo ID as proof of age.
