<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Negative COVID-19 PCR test result taken within 7 days of departure. <b>(For example, a pre-departure COVID-19 PCR test taken on 1<sup>st</sup> September, will be valid for travel until 8<sup>th</sup> September.)</b></li> <li>2. Must be performed by an accredited laboratory.</li> <li>3. Test result must show traveller's full name, date of birth, date of the test, test result, and the name and contact of the laboratory.</li> <li>4. The test result <b>must*</b> be uploaded to the Travel Authorisation.</li> </ol>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Complete the TA application between 1 to 3 days before departure. One for each traveller.</li> <li>2. <b>Upload a negative PCR COVID-19 test result taken no more than 7 days before departure. **</b></li> <li>3. Complete personal and health information.</li> <li>4. Pay \$75 for 10-year-olds and up, \$30 for 9-years-old and younger. <b>Only Visa and Mastercard are accepted.</b></li> <li>5. Sign the TA agreeing to comply with all quarantine and testing requirements. Parents must consent for testing for children 10 to 17-years-old. Without consent, the child(ren) must quarantine for 14-days.</li> <li>6. Keep an electronic or hard copy of the TA to show the airline to be able to board.</li> </ol>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Show the airlines an electronic <b>or</b> hard copy of your TA</li> <li>2. Wear a mask in all public places. Children under the age of 2 must NOT wear a mask.</li> <li>3. Bring a thermometer.</li> <li>4. Keep physical distance at all times.</li> <li>5. Have Health Insurance to cover illness outside of your jurisdiction including COVID-19 related illness.</li> </ol>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Show an electronic <b>or</b> hard copy of your TA to the Health Officer.</li> <li>2. Undergo COVID-19 PCR testing at the airport. You must immediately quarantine until you receive a negative test result (turnaround time is generally less than 24 hours, though results may take longer depending on arrival time).</li> </ol>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Take a taxi or private resident vehicle to your accommodation – <b>NOT</b> public transport.</li> <li>2. Quarantine in your room at your accommodation until arrival test results received. <b>Residents</b> without a pre-departure PCR test <b>MUST</b> quarantine until negative day 8 test results.*</li> <li>3. Travellers with a pre-departure PCR test, test on day 4, 8 and 14. You will be booked into your days and times. These will be emailed to you 24 hours before.</li> <li>4. Monitor your health and record your temperature twice daily and any symptoms.</li> </ol>

\*Required for visiting adults and children age 10 to 17 –years-old. Residents are strongly encouraged to get a negative COVID-19 PCR test result before returning to Bermuda. **Residents without a pre-departure PCR test, quarantine until day 8 negative test results and test again on day 14.**

\*\* Negative COVID-19 PCR Test must be uploaded to obtain a Travel Authorisation. The test result will be vetted before the Travel Authorisation is approved. Children 9-years-old or younger must upload a government issued photo ID as proof of age.
