1.	Is the Day care centre licensed by the Department of Health? (Ask to see the certificate.)	YES	NO
2.	Is the Person-In-Charge certified? (Ask to see the certificate.)	YES	NO
3.	Is there a certified Deputy-Person-In-Charge when the Person-In-Charge is not on the premises? (Ask to see the certificate.)	YES	NO
4.	Can you visit the facility during normal operating hours before registering your child in the program?	YES	NO
5.	Will the staff allow you to examine the area that your child has access to?	YES	NO
6.	Can you visit whenever you wish? (When children are there.)	YES	NO
