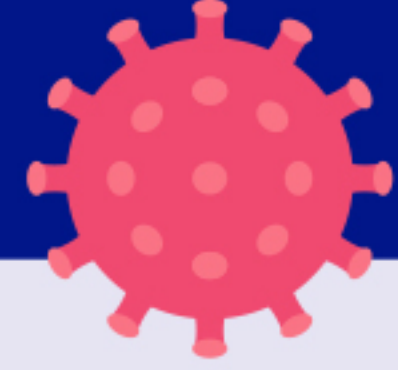
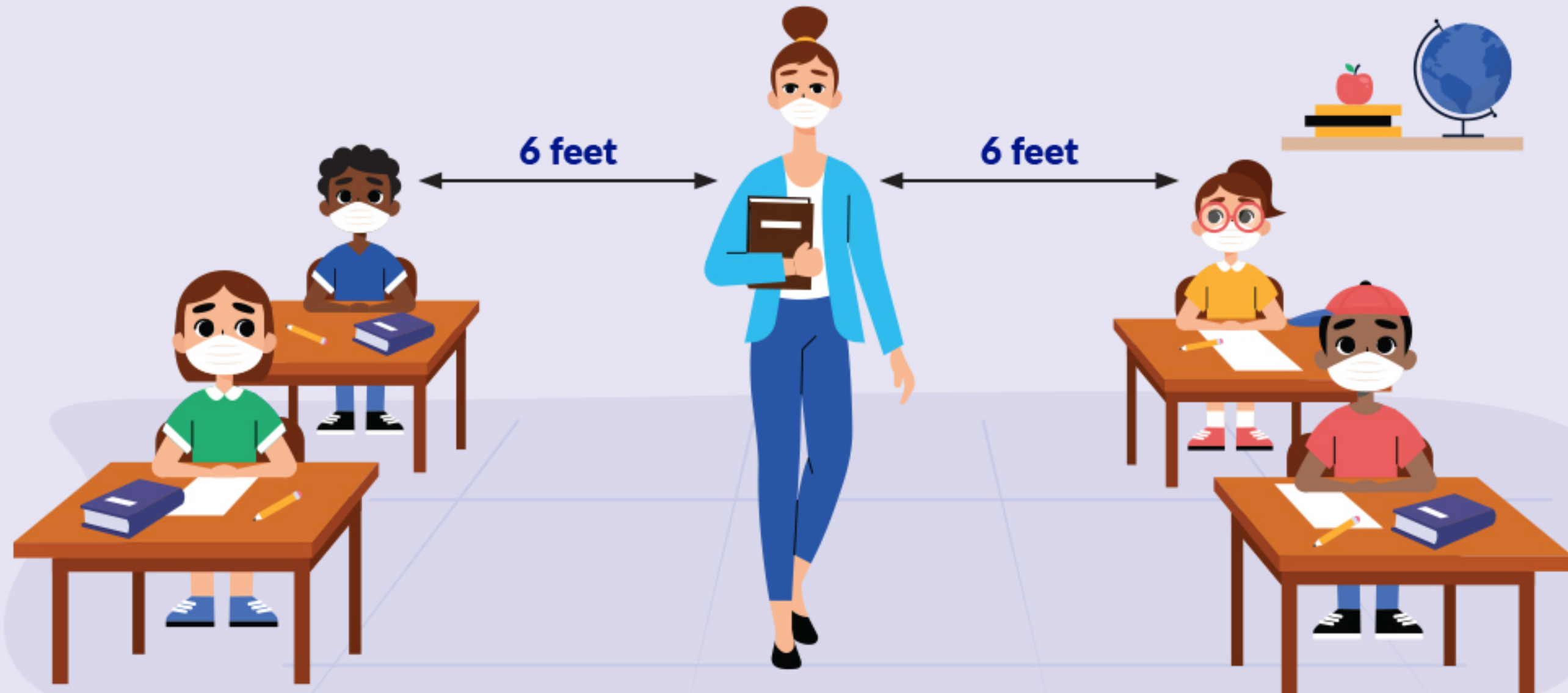


# COVID-19 (Coronavirus)



## What is 'Workplace Isolation' for School/Childcare Facility Employees?



**Immunised** school/childcare facility employees who have travelled abroad must follow the below guidance upon returning to work in Bermuda, until receipt of a negative Day 10 COVID-19 PCR test result.

**Non-immunised** school/childcare facility employees who have travelled abroad must not return to work until receipt of a negative Day 14 COVID-19 PCR test result.

### Classroom

- Maintain 6 feet physical distance from children

### Staffroom

- Do not mingle with colleagues
- Maintain 6 feet physical distance from colleagues or avoid staffroom if possible

### Lunchroom

- Sit alone or have lunch in classroom (*maintain 6 feet physical distance from others, if not alone in classroom*)

### Meetings

- Do not attend unless you can attend virtually (*this applies to both formal and social meetings*)

### Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)

- Wear PPE over clothing if working in close contact with children and/or providing personal care
- Wear a mask at all times

### Personal Hygiene

- Wash hands thoroughly and regularly (*or sanitize hands thoroughly and regularly with disinfectants if washing facilities are not available*)

### Cleaning

- 'Touchpoints' must be cleaned and disinfected thoroughly after use

### Ventilation

- Ensure all rooms used are well ventilated
